## UNIFORM DRESS CODE

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Collared, long or short sleeved, polo Shirt or blouse in solid black, white, or orange</li> <li>✓ Approved school logo shirts are allowed on Fridays</li> <li>✓ Uniform bottoms, cotton twill pants, capris, dresses, skorts, shorts, jumpers or skirts (worn no shorter than 2 inches above the knee) in solid black or khaki/tan</li> <li>✓ Layering of school clothes is permitted provided all layers are within approved school colors (solid black, white, or orange; black or khaki/tan bottoms)</li> <li>✓ Solid black, brown, or white belts</li> <li>✓ Tennis shoes/sneakers or closed toed/closed heeled dress shoes</li> <li>✓ Conservative jewelry should be worn in moderation, limiting the number of pieces worn, and not posing a danger to self or others</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>✓ Collared, long or short sleeved, polo Shirt or blouse in solid black, white, or orange</li> <li>✓ Approved school logo shirts are allowed on Fridays</li> <li>✓ Cotton twill pants or shorts (worn properly on the waist) in solid black or khaki/tan</li> <li>✓ Layering of school clothes is permitted provided all layers are within approved school colors (solid black, white, or orange; black or khaki/tan bottoms)</li> <li>✓ Solid black, brown, or white belts</li> <li>✓ Tennis shoes/sneakers or closed toed/closed heeled dress shoes</li> <li>✓ Conservative jewelry should be worn in moderation, limiting the number of pieces worn, and not posing a danger to self or others</li> </ul>

<i>Outerwear (coats, hoodies, and any sweatshirt or sweater not within Uniform Dress Code guidelines) is to be removed upon entering the building.</i>
<i>Athletic shorts, sweatpants, jazz pants, and leggings are not acceptable uniform bottoms. No jeans or jeggings.</i>
<i>No hats or hoods up on campus at any time in the building.</i>
<i>Flip flops shoes and shoes with wheels are prohibited on campus at any time</i>
<i>Facial piercings are prohibited on campus at any time</i>

### Arts / Athletics Dress Code:

- Performing Arts Focus Dress Code  
 Girls: black or pink leotard, black/pink tights or jazz pants, hair secured off face and neck  
 Boys: black or white t-shirt and dance pants or sweatpants that cover the knee  
 \*\*Shoes: Ballet, Jazz, or Tap shoes are to be provided by the parent. (Please see your child's assigned dance teacher for the shoe requirement.)
  
- Athletics Focus Dress Code  
 Girls and Boys: Solid tee shirt (no tank tops) and athletic shorts, athletic shoes with socks, no jewelry.
  - **Competition uniforms** are to be worn as a complete uniform, as given; no practice clothes allowed at games.
  - **Athletic dress up days for games:** At the coach's discretion, athletic team members may dress up on game days by wearing dresses, dress pants, dress shirts, blazers or suits, and ties; deviation from approved school colors is allowed, if and only if, the student's dress code exceeds or surpasses the uniform dress code requirements.

**South Valley Prep and Arts Academy is a prep school, dedicated to creating a positive learning environment; strict adherence to the dress code is expected. Questions regarding compliance should be directed to the school principal PRIOR to wearing the item in question; the principal's determination of compliance is final.**
